Dear Year 11 Pupils, Parents and Carers,

Results

Pupils' GCSE and BTEC results will be available to collect from school on **Thursday 12th August** between the hours of 9.30-10.30am. Pupils should arrive at reception between these hours and will be shown to the dance studio where they will be able to collect their results. Unfortunately, due to data protection regulations we are unable to give results out by telephone. Due to the current Covid 19 pandemic only pupils will be allowed into school, all other family members will have to remain outside.

Appeals

The Joint Council of Qualifications (JCQ) confirmed that all pupils have the right to appeal their Teacher Assessed Grades. Appeals can only be submitted on the grounds of administrative or procedural errors. Appeals will not be accepted because pupils are not happy with their grade. Appeals with the relevant documentation need to be submitted directly to the school.

We encourage you to familiarise yourself with these documents before results day. Deadline for non-priority appeals to be submitted to school is 3rd September.

Autumn Series

The Government have confirmed that due to the cancellation of examinations this year, pupils will have the opportunity to sit examinations in November/December 2021 if they are unhappy with their grades. Pupils will be eligible to enter for this series if they've received a grade this summer. The exams will be in their normal format, with no adaptations. The usual arrangements for appeals and reviews of marking will apply to the exam series. A replacement certificate will be issued to a

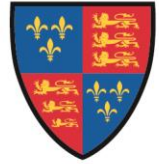
