1 Establish a routine and stick to it. Support you child with checking Class Charts (KS3) and Microsoft Teams (KS4) for new home learning being set by teachers

2 Take an interest – if you are enthusiastic then your child is more likely to be.

3 Monitor online activity and use safety controls and privacy restrictions.

4 Encourage your child to read and read with them – the news, a story, anything helps

5 Ask questions, if you have any, via the email addresses published on the school website and twitter. No need to worry we are here to help and guide you.

6 Keep learning devices in shared spaces in the home

7 Expect your child to be completing and submitting work regularly. If you need further guidance, please see a suggested timetable on the school website under Home Learning

8 If your child does not have a device and/or internet access let school know by phone or email as soon as possible so that alternative arrangements can be put in place.
